The purpose of proposed By-law No. L-17.4 is to impose a special business improvement levy of twenty (20) cents for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessment is imposed, for the calendar year 2023, on non-residential property within the business improvement area designated by By-law No. L-15.
