I am opposed to a new jail being built in Fredericton, or anywhere else in the province.

As a former resident of Lincoln Heights, a family-oriented community, I understood the concerns of parents who were horrified by the prospect of a prison so close by. Why would residents living in other areas of the city welcome such a facility in their neighbourhood?

And why is the provincial government refusing to provide evidence that a new jail is required? The secrecy makes me question whether evidence exists.

If the province were to provide housing – not just shelter – to homeless individuals, they would be less likely to commit crimes and less likely to be the victims of crime.
