BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Fredericton hereby reads a summary of the by-law as follows: The purpose of proposed By-law No. A-26, Delegation of Authority By-law for the City of Fredericton, is to delegate decision making authority to the Chief Administrative Officer to improve organizational efficiency and processing time connected to items of routine business that support departmental services, such as but not limited to procurement matters, approval/exceptions to any by-law related to noise and agreements related to procurement, police services, equipment/vehicle leases, software licensing; and THAT the said by-law be given third reading by title.
