The purpose of proposed By-law No. L-16.5 is to impose a special business improvement levy of twenty (20) cents for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessment is imposed, for the calendar year 2024, on non-residential property within the business improvement area designated by By-law No. L-13.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the City of Fredericton hereby reads a summary of the by-law as follows: The purpose of proposed By-law No. L-16.5 is to impose a business improvement levy on non-residential property of twenty (20) cents for each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessment, for the calendar year 2024, within the downtown business improvement area as requested by Downtown Fredericton Inc. and designated by By-law No. L-13; and THAT the said by-law be given third reading by title.
