MMIWG2S+ Awareness Day (Red Dress Day)

MAY 5th, 2024

WHEREAS MMIWG2S+ stands for Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women,

Girls and Two-Spirited+. MMIWG2S+ is an Indigenous-led inquiry that seeks to spread awareness to all Canadians in working to end violence against Indigenous women, girls, Two-Spirited peoples and gender diverse people, no matter their cultural, geographical, or

historical background.

WHEREAS Half of all women in Canada have experienced at least one incident

of violence since the age of 16 and this reality is worse for Indigenous women as Indigenous women are 12 times more likely to be

murdered or go missing.

WHEREAS MMIWG2S+ is inspiring communities across Canada to educate and

build awareness to end wide-spread domestic and gender-based violence once and for all. We honor and remember the thousands of MMIWG2S+ victims whose lives were taken too soon, and we stand in solidarity with their families and loved ones, acknowledging the

pain and trauma they endure.

THEREFORE In the spirit of reconciliation, I, Kate Rogers, Mayor of Fredericton,

do hereby proclaim that the City of Fredericton shows our support to all Wabanaki people by acknowledging and encouraging others to join activities on May 5th, 2024 as MMIWG2S+ Awareness (Red

Dress) Day in Fredericton.
