Basics of Bike Parking

- Bike rack function should be obvious
- Long term and short term bike parking needs are different
- Racks should provide 2 points of contact for stability and locking points
- Racks must be compatible with standard locking devices
- Install bike facilities close to the anticipated destination
- Long term facilities must have controlled access
- Locations must be safe and secure for bikes and people
- Maintain clean and well-kept facilities
- Provide long term and short term parking options



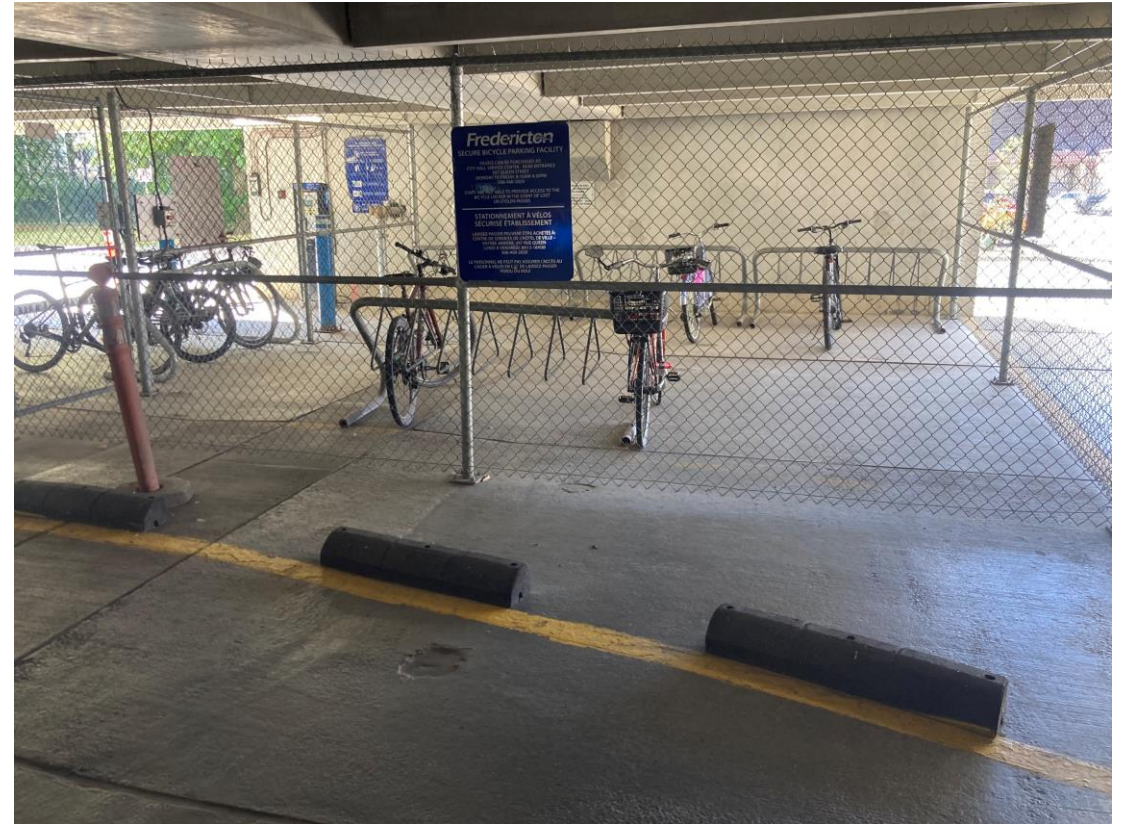
What we have heard

What we have now

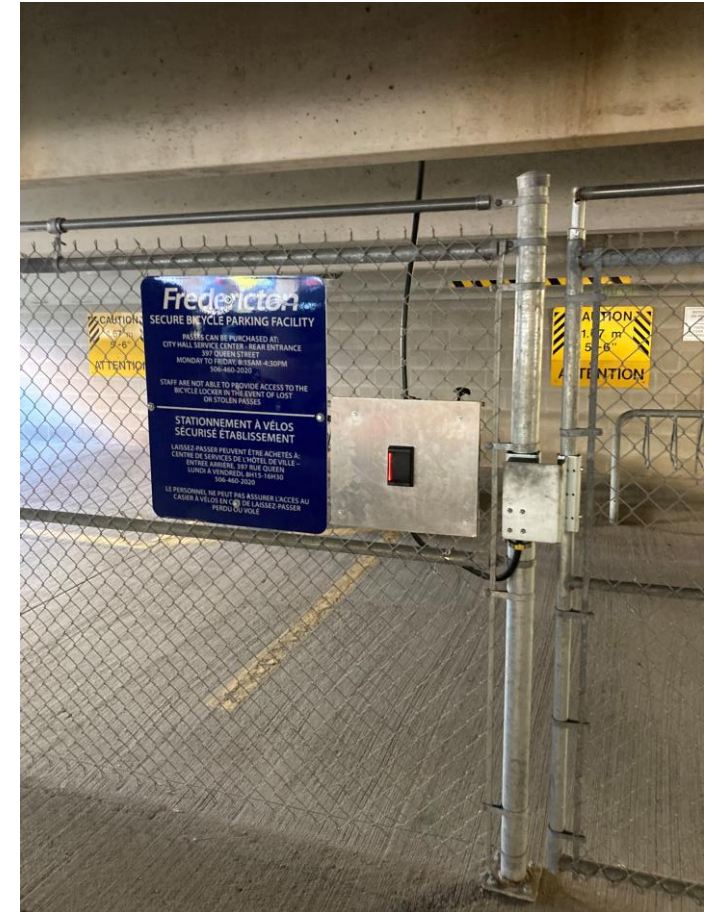
- 2 City owned long term facilities at Fredericks Square and East End Parking Garage
- Short term throughout the Downtown, along trails and around Main Street
- Moderate utility of short term bike parking, low utility of long term bike parking
- Municipal By-law (Z-5) requires bike parking in certain types of residential and nonresidential developments
- Short term bike parking is part of several design plans such as the Mainstreet and Downtown plans
- Recently trialed valet parking as part of Harvest



How to use the city secure bike lockers

To purchase a space in a bike locker, residents will need to fill out an application form beforehand and purchase a locker card at the Service Centre at City Hall. To ensure bicycles are kept safe, each locker card is programmed to a specific bike locker. Here's how much it costs to purchase a card:

- Three months: \$30 (plus tax)
- Six months: \$50 (plus tax)
- One year: \$80 (plus tax)



What we have coming

- Long term bike parking part of the officers square/ Garrison multi plaza project
- Site is well positioned for visibility and near destination
- Reusing existing structure from Sutton House
- Bike racks will continue to be rolled out as per municipal plan standards

How to protect your bike

- Choose prominent and visible locations
- Use a quality Lock
- Use a U lock + cable
- More points the better
- Avoid locking in a way that makes your bike the thief's prybar
- Visually inspect the rack for signs of tampering
- Register your bike for free with **Project 529**
