**Subject: Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) – 2020-21 Top-up Allocation and Program Changes
City of Fredericton – Reference No. (6936.033.0000)**

I would like to notify you that as of June 29, 2021, the program known as the Gas Tax Fund (GTF) has been renamed the **Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF)**. This name change reflects the evolution of the program and does not alter or modify current objectives or requirements.

Fire halls and fire station infrastructure are now eligible investments under the CCBF through a new investment category, Fire Halls. Further details on eligible expenditures will be shared as we receive information from the federal government.

I am pleased to inform you that under the Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF), a one-time 2020-21 top-up allocation of \$4,095,905 is earmarked for the City of Fredericton.

This allocation is to be invested in municipal infrastructure or capacity building projects from the City of Fredericton 2019-2023 Capital Investment Plan (CIP). To receive this 2020-21 top-up, please submit a revised 2019-2023 CIP which includes the top-up allocation noted above.
