Title: Rotary Club of Fredericton North Inc. Dock Project

Council, while acting in Committee, at its session held on June 27, 2022, considered an administrative report from the Recreation Officer seeking Council approval to enter into an agreement with the Rotary Club of Fredericton North Inc. The agreement includes the acceptance of a financial donation to facilitate the purchase and installation of docks with accessible features to be located at Killarney Lake and Morrell Park.

In April of 2022, the Rotary Club of Fredericton North Inc. approached the City of Fredericton on the premise of providing funding through a donation to an approved City of Fredericton project in the amount of \$50,000. It was decided that the funds could be used to improve the dock section at Morrell Park and implement docks with accessible features at Killarney Lake. These docks increase access to water activities in the City of Fredericton, especially for those with mobility disabilities.

By accepting the donation from the Rotary Club of Fredericton North Inc., the City of Fredericton will assume ownership of all materials, responsibility of future costs, yearly instillation, and removal of the docks at both Killarney and Morrell Park subject to annual budget approval. Purchase of material and installation of both docks in 2022 is factored into the overall cost of the project, however at this time there is no operation budget item allocated. Cost of installation and removal of both docks for 2023 is estimated to be \$6000.00. If the donation is accepted and the project is allowed to move forward all materials purchased will be included in the City of Fredericton's Asset Management Inventory.

Accordingly, it was recommended that the following resolution be forwarded to City Council for consideration:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Fredericton hereby acknowledges that the Rotary Club of Fredericton North Inc. as part of a legacy project will donate Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to the City of Fredericton to facilitate the purchase of docks that will be owned solely by the City of Fredericton and will be located at Killarney Lake and Morrel Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Fredericton hereby directs and authorizes the City Treasurer to issue a charitable tax receipt to the Rotary Club of Fredericton North Inc. for their financial donation.
