due to response to Development proposal located at 650 Alison Boulevard:

As a resident of this neighborhood I'm opposed to rezoning property from B1 to I-1 to accommodate a place of worship. Based on provided plans this will be Islamic place of worship. Each Canadian has their right to have their own beliefs or gods.

In this case during each day - 5 times a day- there are calls for prayers..."The call to prayer (adhan) is delivered five times a day by a muadhin to remind Muslims to come to mandatory prayer and leave worldly matters behind..." . During those calls they refer to only one -Islamic-GOD. My religion beliefs are in different God - this is discriminating other religions and believes. "...The main purpose behind the multiple loud pronouncements of adhan in every mosque is to make available to everyone an easily intelligible summary of Islamic belief. In modern times, loudspeakers have been installed on minarets for this purpose..."

Secondly, the size of the proposed buildings and main tower are massive! Main tower height would be around 30m tall- that's 100ft and for sure it will be the only tallest building in radius of 1-2 kilometers. Due to its height it will only create clashes in the neighborhood compared to other existing buildings.

The size of such a building will have an impact on the sun received by other residents. Residents will have to spend more money and time to cover the cost of lack of sun.

As I mentioned in the beginning, everyone has their own right to believe in what they want. Such place of worship or any place of worship should be created outside of occupied by homeowners neighborhoods so there would be NO discriminating for other people.
